**Blend:** 60% Zinfandel, 30%, Syrah, 10%, Cabernet Sauvignon. The Zinfandel is sourced from Amador County, while the Syrah is grown at a highly regarded Paso Robles vineyard, and the Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from vineyards in the Napa Valley.

**Winemaker's Tasting Notes:** The wine starts out powerful yet smooth with ripe, spicy, cherry and tobacco flavors on the mid palate. The finish is accented with cedar and black pepper.

**Twenty Rows Comments:** The wonderful thing about the Twenty Rows is the overall stunning value of the wine. The Grappler is crafted from carefully selected vineyards to yield an intense, deeply colored wine with concentrated aromas and flavors. We named this wine after our sons who dedicated a lot of time and effort to the sport of wrestling hence, The Grappler.
