**Blend:** 100% Merlot

**Appellation:** California. The Merlot is sourced from Carneros and Oak Knoll district in the Napa Valley.

**Fermentation:** Careful tannin management is an important factor to our producing powerful, yet elegant wines. Our fermentation is completed in the barrel, which accelerates early integration of fruit and oak.

**Winemaker Brian Nuss's Tasting Notes:** The Twenty Rows Merlot is a big dense wine with layers of cherry, blackberry plum & mocha with a hint of tobacco. Well balanced with exceptional length on the finish.

**Comments:** We are dedicated to producing an outstanding wine that reflects the varietals which we use in our blend. The 2007 Twenty Rows Merlot is crafted from carefully selected grapes to yield and intense, deeply colored wine with concentrated aromas and flavors.
